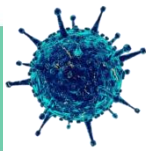

Guidelines for Patient Consultation during Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic

- Patients to follow strict hospital entry protocol by adhering to hand sanitizing and non-contact temperature check by hospital security personnel at the entrance of the hospital

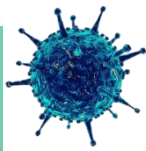


- Proceed to Help desk for assistance related to consultation, give medical details and sign consent form along with questionnaire and declaration forms.



- Patients and accompanying attenders to wear mask to avail consultation, if you don't have the mask, please purchase the mask from the hospital at the help desk (if denied to wear a mask, consultation will not be provided)





- Avoid patient attenders unless patient belong to vulnerable group

VULNERABLE PATIENTS:

- Infants
- Children
- Disabled individuals
- Elderly and frail
- Child Abuse/ Neglect
- Domestic Violence
- Sexual Assault/Abuse
- ALL SCBU /NICU, Comatose patients and patients on mechanical ventilation
- Elder Abuse – Dehydration, fearful at contact, bedsores
- Substance Abuse
- Elderly – 70 years of age/older
- Mental Retardation
- Patient in crisis



- Patients with fever and cough or any other symptoms related to coronavirus, No appointments will be given unless it's an emergency eye care

FEVER

Symptoms* can include

SHORTNESS OF BREATH

COUGH

***Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure.**

- Maintain social distance, the coordinators will guide the patients to the waiting area and will be seated with a gap of two chairs between patients
